

Hal Averett loved many things – history, First Baptist Church, water skiing, helping others, his dogs, travel, and especially his family and countless friends. Columbus has been truly blessed by his energy, his determination and his limitless vision.

The Riverdale-Porterdale Cemetery Foundation is just one of several ideas Hal developed and pursued from first step onward. Beginning in about 2005, he channeled his energies on the need for attention to three downtown cemeteries – the nearly adjacent burial grounds of Columbusites from all walks of life. A casual lunch at his home brought together a small group of people representing various interests and experiences; the number grew, monthly meetings developed, and before long a charitable foundation was in the works. As usual, Mr. Averett never looked back.

Through the ensuing years, Hal developed an important relationship with the Columbus Consolidated Government, with which the foundation has partnered to accomplish many improvements, including landscape enhancements, building restoration and security features. His personal attributes and keen attention to detail have insured the success of endeavors large and small.

Stumbling blocks are inevitable, but for Hal they were minor irritations he found ways to overcome, and sometimes those problems even became challenges he accepted with relish. Time spent near - or on - the river apparently helped overcome frustrations, and renewed his vitality.

This Foundation will continue to grow and develop, thanks to the inspiration and fond memories of Hal Averett.
